Affiliation is 525 euros or an amount in sterling set by your County Board. Cheques in sterling should be made payable to **Ulster Provincial Council IABA**. Cheques in euro should be made payable to **IABA**.

Details about the new insurance policy for members will be available soon.

Club affiliation is due to be with your respective County Board by the end of May. This must be forwarded to the Provincial Secretary by the end of June and must be with Central Council by the end of July.
