Age Requirements: Shall have reached the age of 17 and be under the age of 21 on October 15th 2010.

Other Requirements: Shall not have won a National Senior Championship.

Draw: The draw will take place at 1.15pm on Friday 15th October. It is recommended that clubs have a representative at the draw.

Boxing: Friday 15th 7.00pm
Saturday 16th Contingent on entries.
Friday 22nd 7.30pm
Saturday 23rd Contingent on entries

Men's Weight Categories: 48kg; 51kg; 54kg; 57kg; 60kg; 64kg; 67kg;
71kg; 75kg; 81kg; 85kg; 91kg; 91+kg

Women's Weight Categories: 46kg; 48kg; 51kg; 54kg; 57kg; 60kg; 64kg;
69kg; 75kg; 81kg; 81+kg

Entries: Entries for these Championships should be forwarded to reach the undersigned by **Monday 11th October** at the latest giving name, club, weight division and date of birth. Only boxers for whom entries have been received by that date will be allowed to box.

Men's Boxing will be over 4 X 2 minute rounds.

Women's Boxing will be over 3X2 minute rounds.

Medical Record Cards and entry fee of €15 must be produced at the scales. Any boxer failing to do so will not be permitted to weigh-in. Boxers must advise doctor of any medication they are taking or have taken in the preceding 4 weeks.

Attention is called to the stipulation in the IABA Rule Book that "each boxer presented by his club for competition shall be fit to box. This is the responsibility of his club". And also to have Members Acknowledgement/ Waiver Form signed.

Each Boxer must be clean shaven and have a red and blue vest.

Coaches must be properly attired e.g. tracksuit and runners and endeavour to set a high standard of hygiene in the corners.

It is a condition of entry that all competitors and officials have signed the Members Acknowledgement Form or will not be allowed to participate.
