European Junior Men's Boxing Championships

June 26 to July 3, 2011, Keszthely, Hungary

The European Boxing Confederation and the Hungarian Boxing Association have the pleasure to invite your National Men's Junior boxing team to participate at the EUBC European Men's Junior Championships, to be held in Keszthely, Hungary, June 26 to July 3, 2011.

1. Title of the Event

EUBC European Junior Men's Championships Keszthely 2011

2. Organising bodies

European Boxing Confederation (EUBC), Hungarian Boxing Association and the city of Keszthely

3. Date and place

The **European Junior Men's Boxing Championships** will be held **June 26 to July 3, 2011** in Keszthely, Hungary.

June 26	Arrival of delegations
June 26 to July 2	Competition (Semifinals: July 1, finals: July 2)
July 3	Departure of delegations

4. Participation

Each member federation of the EUBC are allowed to participate in the Championships. Those junior men boxers are **eligible** – in accordance with AIBA rules – **that are aged 15 and 16 years**. The age of a boxer is determined using his/her year of birth.

The **European Junior Men's Boxing Championships** will be organized following the rules of AIBA, under the auspices of EUBC Executive Committee, in the following 13 weight categories:

46 kg, 48 kg, 50 kg, 52 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63 kg, 66 kg, 70 kg, 75 kg, 80 kg, +80 kg.

Each federation is entitled to nominate **one boxer per weight category**.

Duration of bouts: The bouts shall consist of three (3) rounds of two (2) minutes each.
The rest time between rounds is one (1) minute.

Allowed number of personnel for delegations

1 to 3 boxers	2 officials and 1 referee or judge
4 to 6 boxers	3 officials and 1 R&J
7 or more boxers	4 officials and 1 R&J

Each boxer should have a jersey approved by AIBA and a valid record book and a passport.

5. Financial conditions

The organizer provides hotel and accommodation in accordance with the following:

Single room rate	95 €/person/day
Double or triple room	60 €/person/day
For each extra person (above the allowed number) hotel and accommodation (three meals daily) will cost	110 €/person/day

The organizers must provide board and lodging until July 3, 2011, the final meal will be breakfast on that day. Meals will be served in a buffet system.

The participants should order board and lodging with the Organizers.

The Hungarian Boxing Association provides local transportation for the route Budapest-Keszthely-Budapest.

6. Medical attendance

Medical attendance will be provided for the whole duration of the Championships from the day of arrival to the day of departure. Each participant should produce his or her „Europe Health” card (insurance).

7. Prizes, medals

These will be provided by the Organizer.

8. Flags, anthems

Each delegation is asked to bring along their national flag (1 by 2 meters) and their national anthem on CD.

9. Registration, deadline

Provisional entries with weight category April 15, 2011

Final entries with personal data, travel details June 1, 2011

The Organizers are not in a position to accept late entries.

Final entries will be accepted if the country has transferred the **50 percent of its fee in advance payment before June 1, 2011.**

Withdrawal after this date will be penalized by the organizing committee!
