**Age Requirements:**

Shall have reached the age of 17 years and be under 34 years of age on November 18<sup>th</sup> 2011, and have not competed in a National Senior Championship Final and not have won a Senior Provincial Championship or who have competed in the National Senior Championship but have been regarded to Intermediate status.

**Draw:** Will take place at 1.00pm on Friday November 18<sup>th</sup>.

**Weight Categories:**

Women: 46kg;48kg; 50kg; 52kg; 54kg; 57kg; 60kg; 63kg; 66kg  
70kg; 75kg; 80kg; 86kg

Men: 48kg, 51kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 64kg, 67kg, 71kg,  
75kg, 81kg, 85kg, 91kg, 91+kg

Due to additional weight categories and the fact that a boxer may only box once in a day, if entries necessitate a further session may be required. If this happens the session will take place on Sunday morning November 20<sup>th</sup>.

**Entries:**

Entries for these championships should be forwarded in writing to reach the undersigned by Monday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2011. **Only boxers for whom entries have been received by that date will be allowed to box.** Entries must specify weight division and date of birth.

**Boxing:**

Boxing will be over 3 x 3 minute rounds for Men and 4X2 minute rounds for women, medical record cards and entry fee of €15 must be produced at the initial weigh-in. Boxers must present themselves clean shaven and advise details of any medication they are taking or have taken in the preceding 4 weeks.

Attention is called to the stipulation in the IABA Rule Book that “each boxer presented by his club for competition shall be fit to box. This is the responsibility of his club.”

It is a condition of entry that all competitors and officials have signed the Members Acknowledgement Form or will not be allowed to participate.

**Attire:**

Boxers shall have one blue and one red vest. Coaches must wear tracksuits and runners at all sessions and endeavour to set a high standard of hygiene in the corners.

**NB: Red Gum Shields- are strictly prohibited.**
