Proposed running order of Boxing

Friday 5 th May	7.00pm
Saturday 6 th May	10.00am 2.00pm & 7.00pm
12 th & 13 th May	TBC
19 th & 20 th May	Weigh in for Finalists 8-9am

The Above times are subject to change, dependant on entries

Rounds: Boxing will be 3 x 1 ½ Minute Rounds for Girls 1-3

3 x 2 minute rounds for Girl 4 and Juniors 1 & 2

Entries: Provincial Champions and Last year's Champions only sent through the Secretaries of the Provincial Councils and of the Antrim and Dublin County Boards in accordance with Rule 71.1. Entries to reach the undersigned at The National Stadium by Friday 28th April.

Entry Fee: Medical Record Cards and entry fee of 10 Euros must be produced at the initial weigh in. Boxers must advise details of any medication they are taking or have taken in the preceding 4 weeks. Anti Doping may be carried out at any stage of the competition.

Attention is called to the stipulation in the IABA Rule book that each boxer presented by his/her club shall be fit to box. **This is the responsibility of the club.**

Attire: Coaches **must** wear tracksuits and runners in their corners **at all sessions** and endeavour to set a high standard of hygiene. Boxers must wear hairnets or swim caps under their headgear. No red or Pink Gum shields are permitted. Long sleeved tops are not permitted under Vests.

N.B. It is a condition of entry that **all boxers and their clubs have signed and submitted the Members Acknowledgement Form** and it is the responsibility of the entering unit that this stipulation is complied with.
