Duration: Duration of rounds 3x2 Minutes

Eligibility: Boxers born in 2001 and 2002

Weight Divisions:

46kg, 48kg, 50kg, 52kg, 54kg, 57kg (6 Weights Boxed in Ringside Club)

60kg, 63kg, 66kg, 70kg, 75kg, 80kg, 80+kg (7 weights Boxed in National Stadium)

Entry Fee: Medical Record Cards and entry fee of 10 Euros must be produced at the initial weigh in. **Boxers must advise details of any medication they are taking or have taken in the preceding 4 weeks. Anti Doping may be carried out at any stage of the competition.**

Entries: Entries giving name, club, date of birth and weight to reach the under-signed at the National Stadium not later than **Friday 7th July. Please send to sally@iaba.ie** It is a condition of entry that all boxers and their clubs have signed and submitted the Members Acknowledgement Form.

Please note that late entries WILL NOT be accepted.

Attention is call to the stipulation in the Rule Book that each boxer presented by his club for competition shall be fit to box. This is the responsibility of the club

Attire: Boxers must be presented clean shaven at weigh-in. Coaches must wear full tracksuits and runners in the corners at all sessions no caps or hats are permitted, Coaches must endeavour to set a high standard of hygiene. No Red or Orange Gum shields. No international vests to be worn in the ring.

Only officials 18 years of age and over are allowed into the Field of Play.
