15th November 2017

Venue: National Stadium, Dublin

Dates: February 2nd & 3rd, 9th & 10th, 16th & 17th, 23rd & 24th (contingent on entries)

Weigh-in Friday February 2nd at 8.00-11.00am
Novices weigh in on first day and Finals day.
Weigh in times for 9th 16th & 23rd 8.00-9.00am & 12.00-1.00pm
Weigh in times for Sat 10th 17th & 24th 8.00-9.00am

Draw: 2.00pm Friday 2nd February.

Boxing: Friday 2nd Feb at 6.30pm in Ringside Club
Saturday 3rd at 11.00am In Ringside Club

Duration of Rounds:

Novices: Men and Women 3X2 Minute Rounds using 14oz gloves.

Headguards will only be worn by Novices males and all females. Hairnets or Swim caps MUST to be worn under Headguards).

Novices

Men kg 48; 51; 54; 57; 60; 64; 67; 71; 75; 81; 85; 91; 91+ (13 weights)

Women kg 46; 48; 50; 52; 54; 57; 60; 63; 66; 70; 75; 80; 86 (13 weights)

Qualifying Criteria:

Novices: Year of Birth 1978-2000 Age 17-40 years for male and female. **First registered between 1st January 2016 and 31st Dec 2017.**

Please note that the Championship Committee reserves the right to withdraw any boxer at any time during championship. This is in the interest of safety.

Entries:

Medical Record Cards and Entry fee of €20 must be produced at the initial weigh-in.

Entries should be forwarded **to reach the undersigned not later than Wednesday 31st January** giving name, Date of Birth, weight and Club. Entries are subject to vetting and it is a condition of entry that all competitors and officials have signed the Waiver/Members Acknowledgement Form.

Males must present themselves clean shaven and all boxers must advise the doctor of any medication they are taking or have taken in the preceding 4 weeks. Anti Doping may be carried out at any stage of the championships. It is imperative that all boxers adhere to the Anti-Doping Rules and Regulations- any queries regarding this matter please contact Mr Larry Morrison Anti-Doping Officer IABA on 0860292476

Attention is called to the stipulation in the IABA Ltd Rule Book that each boxer presented by his or her club should be fit to box. This is the responsibility of the Club.

Boxers must have one red and one blue vest. **Coaches must wear tracksuits and trainers at all sessions**, and endeavour to set a high standard of hygiene in the corners, no caps will be permitted.

No International Vests to be worn

No Red, Orange or pink Gum shields.

Male Boxers must be Clean shaven

Sportsmanship: all decisions must be accepted in a sporting manner any complaints must be addressed to the Chief Official Stephen Connolly. Please show respect to all Ringside Officials.
