Boxing: 9th, 10th, 16th 23rd & 24th March

Venue: National Stadium, Dublin.

Weigh In & Medical: 9am to 10.00am, Sunday, March 4th at the following venues:

- **Connaught:** Castlerea Boxing Club
- **Leinster and Dublin:** Ringside Club, National Stadium
- **Munster:** Dungarvan Boxing Club
- **Ulster:** Deele College Post Primary School Raphoe County Donegal F93D237
- **Antrim:** Dockers Social Club, Belfast

Following the Provincial Weigh-ins boxers will weigh-in at the national Stadium 8-9am on their first day of boxing and on the day of the finals at 8-9am. **There will be two weigh ins 8-9am & 12-1pm on Friday 9th, 16th and 23rd.**

Draw: 2.00pm on Tuesday 6th March in National Stadium Board room.

At the conclusion of the weigh-in, details of the weights will be sent by email to sally@iaba.ie where the draw will be take place on Tuesday 6th March at approximately 2.00pm. Programme will be sent to all units and posted on the website.

All 6 units are requested to have a representative at the draw.

Weights:

Boy 4 & Junior 1: 27kg; 29kg; 31kg; 33kg; 36kg; 39kg; 42kg; 44kg; 46kg; 48kg; 50kg; 52kg; 54kg; 57kg; 60kg; 63kg; 66kg; 70kg; 75kg; 80kg; 80+ kg.

Junior 2: 29kg; 31kg; 33kg; 36kg; 39kg; 42kg; 44kg; 46kg; 48kg; 50kg; 52kg; 54kg; 57kg; 60kg; 63kg; 66kg; 70kg; 75kg; 80kg; 80+ kg .

Please note that weight classes for all categories conclude with '80+ Kg' in order to comply with corresponding EABA weights. However , for domestic purposes we have included 85kg, 91kg and 91+ kg on entry forms



Rounds: Boxing will be 3 x 1 ½ Minute rounds for Boy 4 and 3 x 2 minute rounds for Junior 1 and Junior 2

Entries: To be made on the enclosed forms and sent through the Secretaries of the Provincial Councils and of the Antrim and Dublin County Boards in accordance with Rule. Entries to reach the undersigned at The National Stadium by Wednesday 28th February.

Entry Fee: Medical Record Cards and entry fee of 10 Euros must be produced at the initial weigh in. Boxers must advise details of any medication they are taking or have taken in the preceding 4 weeks. Anti Doping may be carried out at any stage of the competition.

Attention is called to the stipulation in the IABA Rule book that each boxer presented by his/her club shall be fit to box. **This is the responsibility of the club.**

Attire: Coaches **must** wear tracksuits and runners in their corners **at all sessions** and endeavour to set a high standard of hygiene. **Only qualified coaches are permitted in corners.**

Vests : International vests are not permitted.

N.B. It is a condition of entry that **all boxers and their clubs have signed and submitted the Members Acknowledgement Form** and it is the responsibility of the entering unit that this stipulation is complied with.
