46kg, 48kg, 50kg, 52kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 63kg, 66kg, 70kg, 75kg, 80kg, 80+kg.

Weigh-in for Finals:

Boxers must weigh in on the morning of their Finals, 8 am to 9 am at the National Stadium. **All Boxers must bring an up-to-date passport that must not expire before October 2019 on the first day they box.**

Entry Fee: Medical Record Cards and entry fee of 10 Euros must be produced at the initial weigh in.

Boxers must advise details of any medication they are taking or have taken in the preceding 4 weeks. Anti Doping may be carried out at any stage of the competition.

Entries:

Entries giving name, club, date of birth and weight to reach the under-signed at the National Stadium not later than **Friday 1st March**. It is a condition of entry that all boxers and their clubs have signed and submitted the Members Acknowledgement Form.

Attire:

Coaches must wear full tracksuits and runners in the corners at all sessions, no caps or hats are permitted, Coaches must endeavour to set a high standard of hygiene.

No Red, Pink or Orange Gum shields.

No international vests to be worn in the ring. **Boxers must wear hairnets or swim caps under their headgear.** Long sleeved tops are not permitted under Vests.

Conduct:

Please be advised that Clubs will be held responsible for the conduct of their supporters throughout these Championships.
