Weigh-in: In addition to initial weigh-in, all finalists are required to weigh in on the day of Finals. 8-9am

Entries:

Entries to be submitted on the attached forms by the 4 Provincial Councils plus the Antrim and Dublin Co Boards. In accordance with Rule, each Unit may submit one at each weight. Last year's Irish Champions who were beaten in their respective championships are also entitled to be entered.

Entries to reach The National Stadium by Thursday 25th April.

Entry Fee: Record Cards and entry fee of 10 Euros must be produced at the initial weigh in. Boxers must advise details of any medication they are taking or have taken in the preceding 4 weeks As Anti Doping tests may be carried out at any stage during the competition.

Non-Pregnancy Declaration Forms must be signed and presented for the Official weigh-in.

Attention is called to the stipulation in the IABA Rule book that each boxer presented by his/her club shall be fit to box. **This is the responsibility of the club.**

Attire: Coaches **must** wear tracksuits and runners in their corners **at all sessions** and endeavour to set a high standard of hygiene. **Boxers must wear hairnets or swim caps under their headgear.** No red or Pink Gum shields are permitted. Long sleeved tops are not permitted under Vests.
